1. Epson Cares


Support for Students in Government Schools

We started with 34 schools covering 2,140 students in FY13. And in FY22, we will reach 274 schools covering 21,027 students.









2. Delivering Water Filters

Epson aims to enhance the health of communities by facilitating the availability of clean drinking water in schools.

49 schools in Karnataka's Kolar district have been equipped with state-of-the-art water filters in FY22.




3. Smart Classes

In association with India Literacy Project (ILP), Epson has set up Model Smart Classes or Multi-dimension Learning Spaces and Experiential Labs for 3,874 students across 28 schools in Pavagada, Tumkur District, Karnataka during FY2019-20.

4. Supporting Students in an NGO-run School

The Good Harvest School is an agriculture-based school for rural girls in Uttar Pradesh's Unnao district. A noble initiative aimed at ensuring quality education for rural girls and to help them pursue their aspirations.

Epson donated 2 projectors and an EcoTank printer to the Good Harvest School - to help unlock their creative potential and cultivate critical skills to set them on the path for great things to come.

5. Anti-tobacco Campaigns

A campaign that began in FY19 with 141 schools / colleges covering 160,000 students has only grown in strength.





In Association with Sambandh Health Foundation (SHL), Epson India is supporting the Tobacco Free Youth campaign across Karnataka, West Bengal, Andhra Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh (which are the highest affected states due to Tobacco).

The campaign has reached 175,000 students across 10,000 schools and colleges during 2021-22. The objective is to raise awareness about the harmful effects of Tobacco in order to help reduce the consumption rates and ensure a longer life.

6. COVID-19 Relief

Epson contributed INR 27 lakhs for 25 Oxygen Concentrators to the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) / International Association for Human Values (IAHV) for the fight against COVID-19 in Delhi and Bangalore.

Epson has also donated INR 119 lakhs to the PM Cares fund.
