



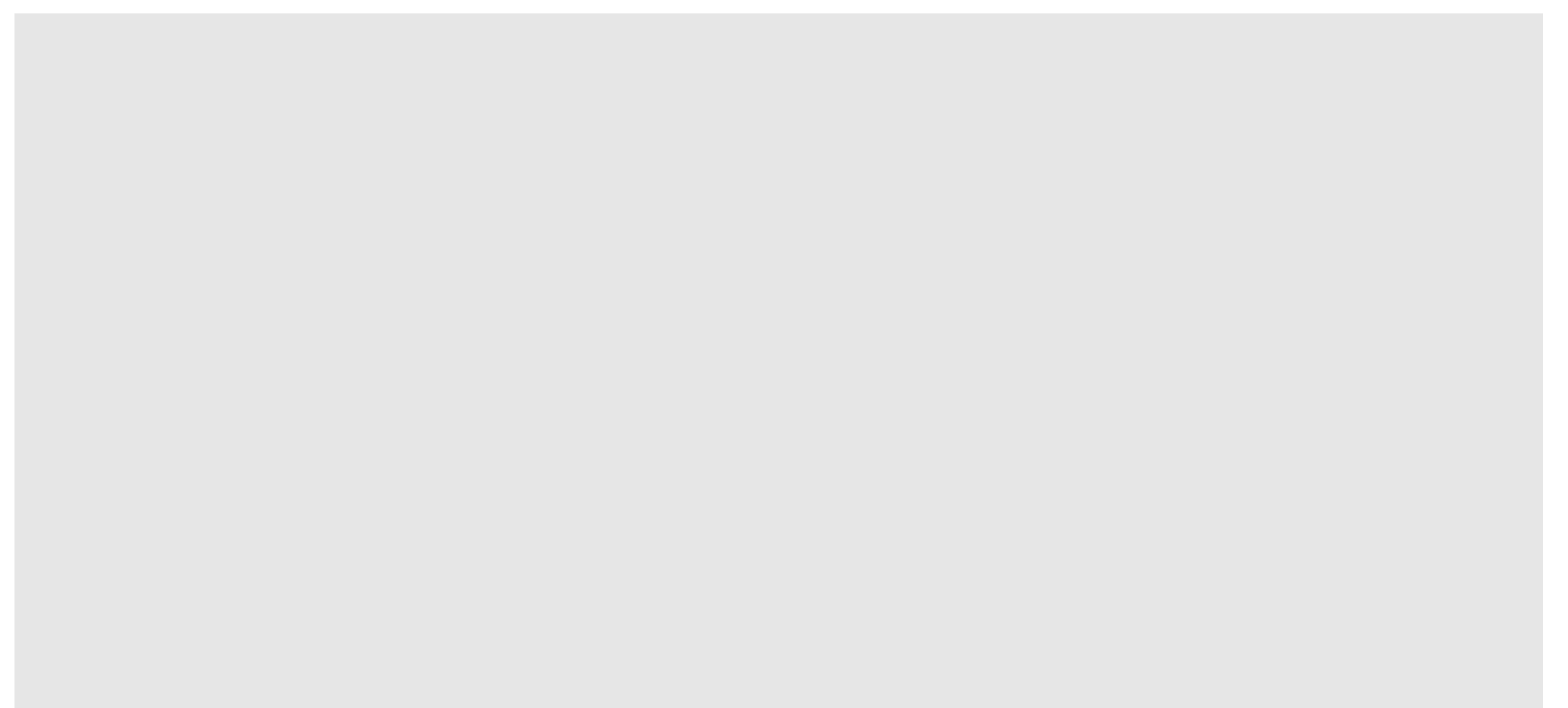
## 3 reasons why you should get a CAD printer
