"Our marketing department spent a lot of time gathering information and taking pictures of many different fasteners for our database. We have worked hard to set up the structure of our database in Excel, as well as add descriptors, color codes and variable images associated with every single SKU we sell," mentioned Buechler. "Incorporating color coding and icons across all our SKUs were just two of the many features we wanted so that our products continue to stand out."

"These two capabilities alone have helped us with warehouse management and organization. We can easily shelf and identify inventory products with the color tags included on labels. The personalized labels include part numbers and product image to help ensure customers can easily locate the products they need," said Buechler.
