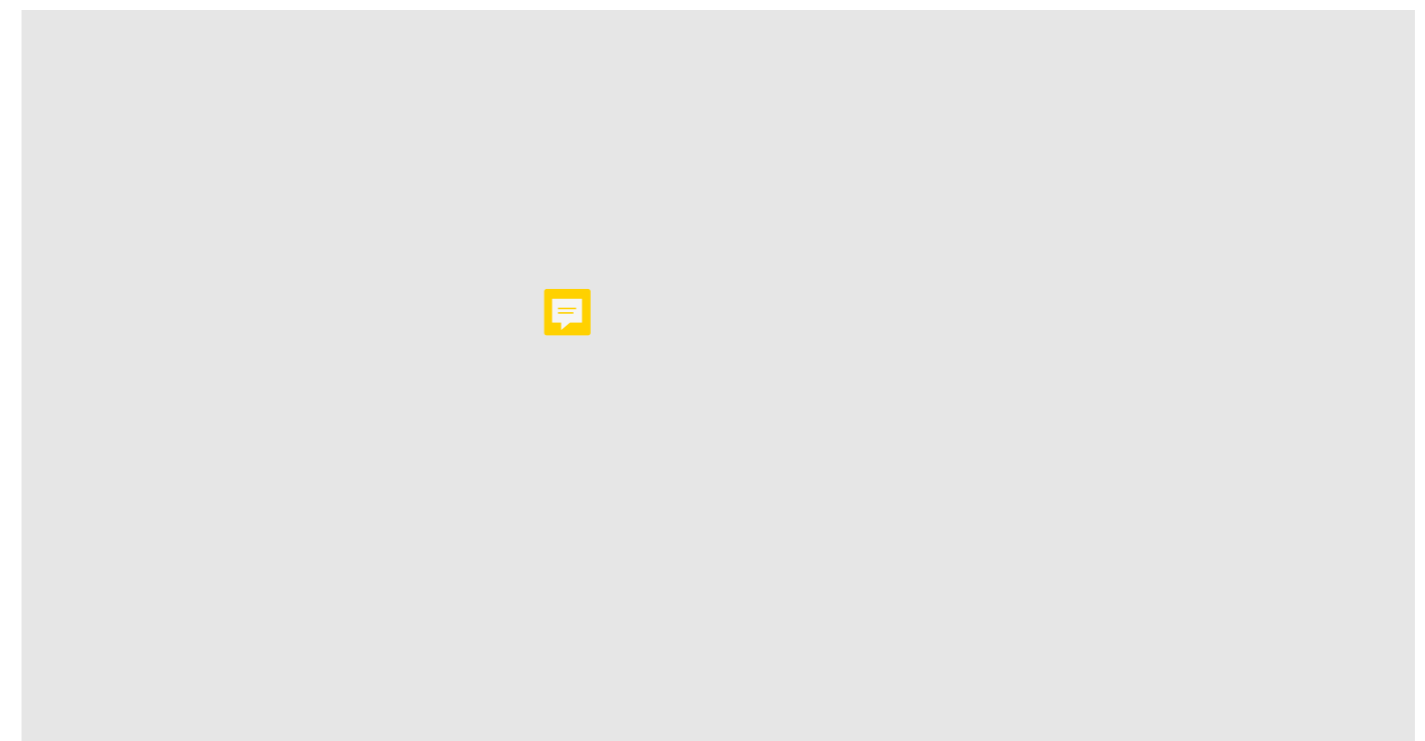




The brilliance of interactive projection
