You can now activate multiple Epson PreferredSM Plus Extended Service Plans at once. This convenient, time-saving solution makes it easier than ever to protect your devices. To prevent service delays, customers are encouraged to activate their extended service plans as they deploy¹. Follow the instructions provided to learn how you can get up and running quickly with multi-service plan activation.

Before you begin, make sure you have the following information for each device you would like to activate:

Activation Code (found in "Reminder: Activate your Epson® Service Plan today" email sent from Epson after purchase)			
Hardware Serial Number			
Hardware Purchase Date			
Zip/Postal Code (Place of Installation)			
Hardware Place of Purchase (not needed for resellers)			

Multi-Service Plan Activation Instructions

Start by visiting the Service Plan Activation Page.
Select "Business" or "Reseller/Integrator,"
complete the forms, then follow the steps below:

- 1 Select the "Upload File Activation" option.
- Click on "Download.xlsx Template." Fill out the template and save the file to your computer.

- Return to the Epson Activation Page and select "Choose."
- Select the completed template from your computer and click "Upload."
- Once uploaded, click "Next" to see a summary of your file.
- If everything looks correct, click "Submit Activations" to complete your multi-service plan activation.

You will receive a confirmation email containing serial numbers and expirations for your extended service plans when activation is complete. If you are a reseller, both you and your customer may receive confirmation emails depending on contact information provided. You can verify your coverage at www.epson.com/w/warranty at any time.
